

第5節 医学系総合研究棟の新設

2021年4月、千葉大学亥鼻キャンパスに医学系総合研究棟(治療学研究棟)が完成した。

本施設の新築はPFI(Private Finance Initiative)事業として実施され、グローバル化に対応した次世代の多様なニーズに応える医療人育成のため、教育研究基盤の構築と未来の医療を担う治療学研究拠点を創成する施設建設を目指した。

完成した11階建て40,000㎡の新棟は、研究領域が異なる研究者間の交流とコミュニケーションを引き出すため、建物の端部まで人と人との視覚的につながり、明るく開放感のある施設となった。

1階から4階に講義室、実習室、グループ学習室、福利厚生施設等が、5階から11階には基礎系・臨床系の研究室や実験室、プロジェクト研究スペース等が配置された。また、附属病院との間に連絡通路を設け、接続させることで一層の機能連携の強化を図った。

建物の外観は、千葉大学医学部の歴史と先進性を表すデザインを採用した。低層部の外壁は、旧医学部本館のタイル色と風合いを再現、歴史の継承と重厚感を表し、高層部は白系統色を基調とした縦ラインのデザインにより先進性を表している。

SECTION 5: NEWLY-CONSTRUCTED RESEARCH BUILDING OF MEDICAL SCIENCE

In April 2021, the Research Building of Medical Science (Therapeutic Research Building) was completed on Chiba University's Inohana Campus.

The construction of this new facility was carried out as a PFI (Private Finance Initiative) project, and in order to develop medical personnel capable of meeting the diverse needs of the next generation in response to globalization, we set out to construct an educational research base, and create a therapeutic research facility that would serve as a base for future medical care.

The newly-completed 11-story, 40,000m² building is a bright and open facility, with visual connections between people all the way to the ends of the building in order to encourage interaction and communication between researchers in different research fields.

Lecture rooms, practical training rooms, group study rooms, welfare facilities, etc., are located on the 1st to 4th floors, and basic and clinical laboratories, laboratories, project research spaces, etc., are located on the 5th to 11th floors. In addition, a connecting passageway was built between the Research Building of Medical Science and the University Hospital to further strengthen functional cooperation.

For the exterior of the building, we adopted a design that represents the history and innovation of the Chiba University School of Medicine. The outer wall of the lower floors reproduces the tile color and texture of the former Main Building of the School of Medicine, expressing the succession of history and a sense of dignity.
