Address: 1-4-8 Mitsuwadai, Wakaba-ku, Chiba City, 264-0032

3-minute walk from "Danchi Iriguchi" bus stop on the Chiba Inland Bus Mitsuwadai Line.

Or approximately 20 minutes by bicycle to Chiba University and Keiai University.

Permitted period of residence:

In principle, six years from the month of moving in as long as you are enrolled in a university or graduate school.

Room fee:
